

Who May Become an IALS Member?

IALS has both voting and non-voting members. Voting members are institutions offering legal education. Non-Voting members include individual legal educators and associations of law schools. All members are committed to the principles and mission of the Association and to paying dues in an amount established by the Governing

Board. Specific membership requirements and the membership application can be found on the IALS web site at

www.ialsnet.org.

Each voting member has one vote in the General Assembly, which is the ultimate authority of the Association. To assure that IALS will not be dominated by law schools in any single country the charter provides that, regardless of the number of voting members from any one country, no more than 10 percent of the vote totals in the General Assembly may be from such country.

The General Assembly elects eighteen members to Governing Board. The Governing Board consists of four officers (President, President-elect, Immediate Past President, and General Secretary/Treasurer). No country may have more than one member of the Governing Board except that one additional person may serve as an officer.
